Matchbox Pictures and Screenwest – Indigenous Director Attachment

Program overview

In line with Screenwest's Indigenous Screen Strategy to create pathways for the Indigenous Screen sector, Matchbox WA and Screenwest have partnered to provide a Directors Attachment opportunity for a mid to advanced career Western Australian Indigenous Director. This attachment will be on *The Heights*, a 30 x ½ hour television series for the ABC, which is currently filming in Perth until end September 2018.

Indigenous Western Australian directors who possess at least two (2) broadcast or theatrical credits and who are looking to develop their career in Television are encouraged to apply.

Through the initiative the successful candidate will undertake a Director attachment with Matchbox WA, shooting in Perth for up to eight (8) weeks. This will include hands-on experience and high-level industry mentoring.

This attachment is aimed at progressing and developing the career of an WA Indigenous Director in order for them to gain television and on-set experience. The successful recipient is anticipated to commence in July 2018, subject to the finalization of the production schedule.

Funding available

There will be one (1) successful applicant who will be offered a high-level opportunity. The level of Screenwest's funding commitment will be determined by the total demand on available funds. Funding is provided as a grant for practitioner development activities and the applicant will receive an agreement specifying conditions, including how the grant will be cash flowed and what deliverables are required.

Eligibility

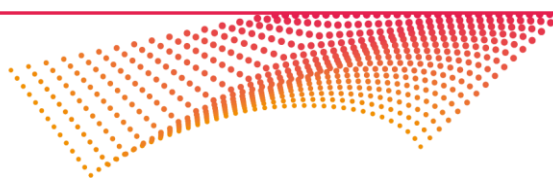
An application must first meet the following eligibility criteria

The applicant must:

1. Meet the general eligibility requirements set out in the [Screenwest Terms of Trade](#).
2. Be an Indigenous Western Australian resident.
3. Have at least two (2) broadcast or theatrical credits as a Director.

How to apply

All applicants will need to submit the following:



1. A current CV with two professional references. Please include any relevant short or project credits, or relevant professional special achievements (max 2 pages).
2. Half a-page proposal that introduces you as the applicant and outlines how this opportunity will progress the applicant's career; why the applicant should be the successful candidate.

Applicants must ensure all requested material is completed and submitted together. Applications that do not include all requested material may not be accepted. Applicants will be assessed by Matchbox WA.

Closing date

All application materials must be submitted by **5:00pm (WST) Monday July 2**
Late applications will not be accepted.

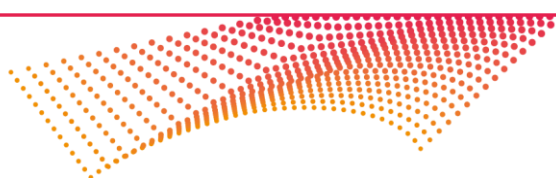
