FUNDING RECIPIENT'S RESPONSIBILITY

It is the funding recipient's responsibility to ensure that they have read their contract that stipulates when and where logo acknowledgement is required.

It is also the responsibility of the funding recipient to seek final clearance and approval of the logo acknowledgement from Screenwest prior to the project or publicity materials being locked-off; failure to do so will result in the funding recipient being liable for making any corrections.

SCREENWEST MASTER LOGO

The singular Screenwest master logo is only used when prescribed by Screenwest. This logo is never used for end credits unless specifically required.

SCREENWEST TRI-BADGE LOGO

The tri-badge logo consists of the WA Government crest, Screenwest logo and 'Lotterywest supported' logo.

The only time the tri-badge logo is not used is productions that also receive Australian Broadcasting Corporation (ABC) funding; in these circumstances the co-badge logo is used. The co-badge logo consists of the WA Government Crest and Screenwest logo.

1.4 ON-SCREEN CREDITS

HEAD/FRONT CREDITS

All projects that receive production funding from Screenwest must contain a presentation credit in the head/front credits, or where there are no font credits, in a prominent position and not as the last credit.

The copy can be written in the font of the credits.

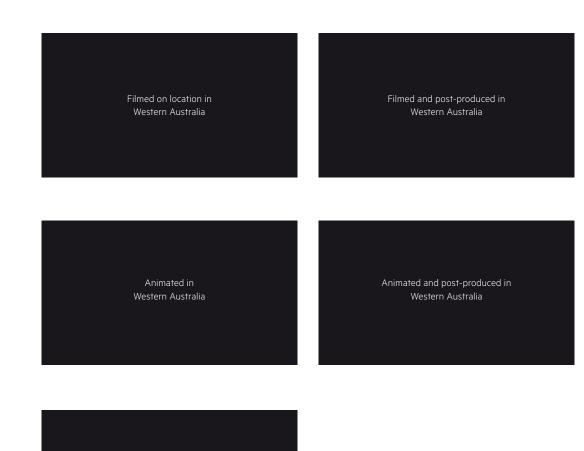


END CREDITS

All projects that receive Screenwest production funding must also include one of the following as a single frame credit in the end credits to recognise that filming/animation and/or post-production took place in Western Australia.

If activity also occurred in another state/ country, additional locations can be recognised within the single frame credit.

The copy can be written in the font of the end credits.

The individual elements of the tri-badge logo must not be separated or altered under any circumstance, and the size and relationship of the elements must always stay the same.

1.5 COLOUR REPRODUCTION

The tri-badge logo can be reproduced as:

- · Full colour
- · Monotone in black
- In a single theme or corporate colour
- In reverse (i.e. white over a dark background).

Chemproofs should be used to check colours prior to offset print production. Colours for all reproduction methods should be matched as closely as possible to Pantone standards.

1.6 REVERSING THE TRI-BADGE LOGO

The tri-badge logo may be reversed from solid background colours, but black is preferred.

When reversing the logo, it may appear as either:

- 1. All in colour
- 2. All in white.

The logo should not be reversed from a photographic or textured background – the background must be solid.







CO-BADGE

The ABC is exempt from publishing the Lotterywest logo due to legislative requirements.

Therefore for productions with ABC funding, the co-badge logo is to be used.

2.1 CO-BADGE LOGO (ABC FUNDED PROJECTS ONLY)

The co-badge logo is available in three electronic formats:

- EPS + Ai for professional printing or high quality reproduction, i.e. advertisements, brochures, leaflets, signage. These formats are standard for the printing industry.
- JPEG low-resolution format suitable for online use, internally printed newsletters and press kits, Powerpoint presentations.
- PNG transparent background, lowresolution format suitable for online use, internally printed newsletters and press kits, Powerpoint presentations.

2.2 ON-SCREEN CREDITS

For ABC funded projects, the co-badge is to be used, however Lotterywest is acknowledged in the written form.

HEAD/FRONT CREDITS

All projects that receive prodution funding from Screenwest must contain a presentation credit in the head/front credits or where there are no front credits, in a prominent position or not as the last credit.

The copy can be written in the front of the end credits.

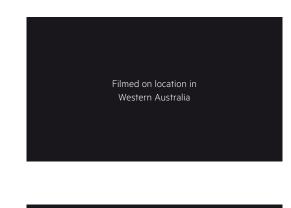


END CREDITS

All projects that receive Screenwest production funding must also include one of the following as a single frame credit in the end credits to recognise that filming/animation and/or post-production took place in Western Australia.

The copy can be written in the font of the end credits.











The individual elements of the co-badge logo must not be separated or altered under any circumstance, and the size and relationship of the elements must always stay the same.

2.3 COLOUR REPRODUCTION

The co-badge logo can be reproduced as:

- Full colour
- Monotone in black
- In a single theme or corporate colour
- In reverse (i.e. white over a dark background).

Chemproofs should be used to check colours prior to offset print production. Colours for all reproduction methods should be matched as closely as possible to Pantone standards.

2.4 REVERSING THE CO-BADGE LOGO

The co-badge logo may be reversed from solid background colours, but black is preferred.

When reversing the logo, it may appear as either:

- 1. All in colour
- 2. All in white.

The logo should not be reversed from a photographic or textured background – the background must be solid.

2.5 MINIMUM SIZE

The minimum width for positive reproduction of the co-badge and tri-badge logos are specified. The minimum size refers to the block of all elements.

2.6 EXCLUSION ZONE

To ensure that the co-badge and tri-badge logos are never 'crowded' with other logos, pictures or symbols please make sure that you follow the exclusion zone guidelines.

SEPARATE OR REARRANGE THE ELEMENTS OF THE LOGO



DISTORT THE LOGO



CHANGE THE SIZE OF ANY ELEMENT OF THE LOGO



RE-CREATE ANY OF THE LOGO ELEMENTS USING DIFFERENT FONTS



PRINT THE LOGO TOO SMALL



ATTACH SERVICE OR PRODUCT DESCRIPTORS TO THE LOGO
